

321.207 Downgrade of commercial driver's license or commercial learner's permit.

The department shall adopt rules for downgrading a commercial driver's license or commercial learner's permit to a noncommercial status upon a driver's failure to provide a medical examiner's certificate as required pursuant to [section 321.188, subsection 1](#), paragraph "d", upon a driver's failure to provide a self-certification of type of driving as required pursuant to [section 321.188, subsection 1](#), paragraph "d", or upon receiving notification of the driver's prohibited status pursuant to [49 C.F.R. §383.73\(q\)](#). The rules shall include procedures regarding notification of downgrade status to the commercial driver's license information system, termination of a downgrade process, and reinstatement of a commercial learner's permit or commercial driver's license after a downgrade, and shall substantially comply with [49 C.F.R. §383.71](#) and [383.73](#), as adopted by rule by the department.
