Auditor of State Rob Sand today released a report on the University of Northern Iowa, Cedar Falls, Iowa for the year ended June 30, 2024. The University of Northern Iowa previously released its annual financial report for the year ended June 30, 2024.

The University of Northern Iowa is governed by the Iowa Board of Regents. For the year ended June 30, 2024, the full-time equivalent student enrollment was 7,087 with an average cost per student of \$19,135, compared to 7,117 students and an average cost per student of \$18,832 for the year ended June 30, 2023.

AUDIT FINDINGS:

Consistent with the prior year, Sand reported no findings related to the receipt and expenditure of taxpayer funds.

We have also audited the University's compliance with the types of compliance requirements identified as subject to audit in U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Compliance Supplement that could have a direct and material effect on the University's major federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2024 and have issued our report thereon dated March 3, 2025.
