follows:
    a. In computing the compensation to be allowed a
volunteer fire fighter, emergency medical care
provider, reserve peace officer, volunteer ambulance
driver, volunteer emergency rescue technician as
defined in section 147A.1, or emergency medical
technician trainee, the earnings as a fire fighter,
emergency medical care provider, reserve peace
officer, volunteer ambulance driver, volunteer
emergency rescue technician, or emergency medical
technician trainee shall be disregarded and the
volunteer fire fighter, emergency medical care
provider, reserve peace officer, volunteer ambulance
driver, volunteer emergency rescue technician, or
emergency medical technician trainee shall be paid an
amount equal to the compensation the volunteer fire
fighter, emergency medical care provider, reserve
peace officer, volunteer ambulance driver, volunteer
emergency rescue technician, or emergency medical
technician trainee would be paid if injured in the
normal course of the volunteer fire fighter's,
emergency medical care provider's, reserve peace
officer's, volunteer ambulance driver's, volunteer
emergency rescue technician's, or emergency medical
technician trainee's regular employment or an amount
equal to one hundred and forty percent of the
statewide average weekly wage, whichever is greater.
    Sec. __. Section 85.61, subsection 2, Code
Supplement 1995, is amended to read as follows:
    2. "Employer" includes and applies to a person,
firm, association, or corporation, state, county,
municipal corporation, school corporation, area
education agency, township as an employer of volunteer
fire fighters, volunteer emergency rescue technicians,
and emergency medical care providers only, benefited
fire district, and the legal representatives of a
deceased employer. "Employer" includes and applies to
a rehabilitation facility approved for purchase-of-
service contracts or for referrals by the department
of human services or the department of education.
    Sec. __. Section 85.61, subsection 11, unnumbered
paragraph 3, Code Supplement 1995, is amended to read
as follows:
    "Worker" or "employee" includes an emergency
    medical care provider as defined in section 147A.1, a
    volunteer emergency rescue technician as defined in
    section 147A.1, a volunteer ambulance driver, or an
    emergency medical technician trainee, only if an
    agreement is reached between such worker or employee
    and the employer for whom the volunteer services are
    provided that workers' compensation coverage under
    chapters 85, 85A, and 85B is to be provided by the
