1 4 "Sec. 101. Section [56.6](#), subsection 1, paragraph  
1 5 a, Code 1999, is amended to read as follows:  
1 6 a. Each treasurer of a committee shall file with  
1 7 the board or commissioner disclosure reports of  
1 8 contributions received and disbursed on forms  
1 9 prescribed by rules as provided by chapter 17A. The  
1 10 reports from all committees, except those committees  
1 11 for municipal and school elective offices and for  
1 12 local ballot issues, shall be filed on the nineteenth  
1 13 day or mailed bearing a United States postal service  
1 14 postmark dated on or before the nineteenth day of  
1 15 January, May, July, and October of each year. The  
1 16 May, July, and October reports shall be current as of  
1 17 five days prior to the filing deadline. The January  
1 18 report shall be the annual report covering activity  
1 19 through December 31.
