OF IOWA.
    1. The governor shall appoint a committee
consisting of fifty-four citizens of this state who
meet the criteria of "learned persons" to translate
the Code of Iowa into American English. The committee
shall complete its duties no later than June 30, 2003.
    2. One-fifth of the members of the committee, as
nearly as possible, shall be residents of each
congressional district of this state and each one-
fifth portion of the committee shall serve as a
subcommittee. The committee shall meet to determine
the duties assigned to each of the five subcommittees.
    3. The guidelines that the committee shall use in
its translation of the Code of Iowa are:
    a. Follow the Code of Iowa so far as the fidelity
to the original sources will allow.
    b. Maintain the current chapters, only reordering
chapters where strictly necessary.
    c. Where especially difficult passages occur,
preference shall be given to the most commonly
accepted translation by the average learned Iowan.
            d. Any words that need to be inserted for
colloquial reasons shall be printed in italics.
    e. Inclusive language efforts shall be made to
reach gender neutrality.
            f. Final recommendations of the committee shall
include the recognition of the definitive "English
language" reference books to be used for future
volumes and state documents.
    4. The committee shall issue its final report in
writing to the governor and to the general assembly."
