(2) The attending physician certifies that the 2 46 2 47 fetus is physically deformed, mentally deficient, or 2 48 afflicted with a congenital illness. 2 49 (3) The pregnancy is the result of a rape which is 2 50 reported within 45 days of the incident to a law 1 enforcement agency or public or private health agency 2 which may include a family physician.
3 (4) The pregnancy is the result of incest which is 4 reported within 150 days of the incident to a law 5 enforcement agency or public or private health agency 6 which may include a family physician. (5) The abortion is a spontaneous abortion, 3 8 commonly known as a miscarriage, wherein not all of 9 the products of conception are expelled. 3 10 The total quota allocated to the counties for 3 11 indigent patients for the fiscal year beginning July 3 12 1, 2003, shall not be lower than the total quota 3 13 allocated to the counties for the fiscal year 3 14 commencing July 1, 1998.
