1 1 Amend Senate File 2288, as amended, passed, and
1 2 reprinted by the Senate, as follows:
1 3 #1. Page 14, by inserting after line 19, the
1 4 following:
1 5 1 6 block grant to be received exceeds the amount
1 7 appropriated in this section and the excess amount is
1 8 sufficient to fund both the purposes identified by the
1 9 department for the excess amount and the purpose
1 10 described in this sentence, notwithstanding contrary
1 11 provisions of 2004 Iowa Acts, Senate File 2298, if
1 12 enacted, the department shall, to the extent
1 13 sufficient funds are available, set child care
1 14 provider reimbursement rates based on the most
1 15 recently completed rate reimbursement survey. Moneys
1 16 appropriated in this section that remain unencumbered
1 17 or unobligated at the close of the fiscal year shall
1 18 revert to be available for appropriation for purposes
1 19 of the child care and development block grant in the
1 20 succeeding fiscal year.>
