1 1 Amend Senate File 36, as passed by the Senate, as
1 2 follows:
1 3 #1. Page 1, by inserting before line 1 the
1 4 following:
1 5 <Section 1. Section 257.1, subsection 2,
1 6 unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 2005, is amended by
1 7 striking the unnumbered paragraph and inserting in
1 8 lieu thereof the following:
1 9 The regular program foundation base per pupil is
1 10 the following:
1 11 a. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2005,
1 12 the regular program foundation base per pupil is
1 13 eighty-nine and twenty-eight hundredths percent of the
1 14 regular program state cost per pupil.
1 15 b. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2006,
1 16 the regular program foundation base per pupil is
1 17 ninety-one and six hundredths percent of the regular
1 18 program state cost per pupil.
1 19 c. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2007,
1 20 the regular program foundation base per pupil is
1 21 ninety-two and eighty-four hundredths percent of the
1 22 regular program state cost per pupil.
1 23 d. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2008,
1 24 the regular program foundation base per pupil is
1 25 ninety-four and sixty-two hundredths percent of the
1 26 regular program state cost per pupil.
1 27 e. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2009,
1 28 the regular program foundation base per pupil is
1 29 ninety-six and forty hundredths percent of the regular
1 30 program state cost per pupil.
1 31 f. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2010,
1 32 the regular program foundation base per pupil is
1 33 ninety-eight and eighteen hundredths percent of the
1 34 regular program state cost per pupil.
1 35 g. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2011,
1 36 and succeeding budget years, the regular program
1 37 foundation base per pupil is one hundred percent of
1 38 the regular program state cost per pupil.
1 39 For each budget year the special education support
1 40 services foundation base is seventy-nine percent of
1 41 the special education support services state cost per
1 42 pupil. The combined foundation base is the sum of the
1 43 regular program foundation base and the special
1 44 education support services foundation base.>
1 45 #2. Page 1, by striking lines 15 through 17 and
1 46 inserting the following:
1 47 <Sec. _____. The section of this Act increasing the
1 48 regular program foundation base is enacted,
1 49 notwithstanding the subject matter restrictions of
1 50 section 257.8, subsection 1.
2 1 Sec. _____. APPLICABILITY. The section of this Act
2 2 establishing a state percent of growth for the budget
2 3 year beginning July 1, 2006, is applicable for
2 4 computing state aid under the state school foundation
2 5 program for the school budget year beginning July 1,
2 6 2006.>

2 8 inserting the following: <An Act relating to the
