However, the 1 1 1 1 42 vacancy shall not be filled in this manner unless the 43 officer appointed to fill the vacancy agrees in 44 writing with the board of supervisors to assume the 1 1 1 45 duties of the vacant office. The appointment shall be 46 for the period until the next pending election as 1 1 47 defined in section 69.12, and shall be made within 1 48 forty days after the vacancy occurs.
