NEW SUBSECTION. 10. Notwithstanding subsection 7A
and subsection 9, paragraph "a", beginning July 1,
2005, the state court administrator shall allocate to
the department of public safety for the fiscal year
beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006, one
million seventy=eight thousand eight hundred eight
dollars, and for each fiscal year thereafter, six
hundred fifty=one thousand five hundred forty=six
dollars, to be drawn first from funds otherwise
allocated to the vehicle depreciation account of the
