Section 249A.4, subsection 8, 5 unnumbered paragraphs 1 and 3, Code 2005, are amended 1 1 6 to read as follows: 7 Shall advise and consult at least semiannually with 1 1 1 8 a council composed of the presidents or directors of 9 the following organizations <u>or agencies</u>, or a 10 president's representative who is a member of the 1 1 11 organization represented by the president, or a 1 12 director's representative: the Iowa medical society, 1 13 the Iowa osteopathic medical association, the Iowa 1 14 academy of family physicians, the Iowa chapter of the 1 15 American academy of pediatrics, the Iowa physical 16 therapy association, the Iowa dental association, the 17 Iowa nurses association, the Iowa pharmacy 1 1 18 association, the Iowa podiatric medical society, the 19 Iowa optometric association, the Iowa association of 1 1 20 community providers, the Iowa psychological 21 association, the Iowa psychiatric society, the Iowa 1 1 22 chapter of the national association of social workers, 23 the coalition for family and children's services in 24 Iowa, the Iowa hospital association, the Iowa 1 1 25 association of rural health clinics, the opticians' 26 association of Iowa, inc., the Iowa association of 27 hearing health professionals, the Iowa speech and 1 1 28 hearing association, the Iowa health care association. 29 the Iowa association of area agencies on aging, AARP, 30 the Iowa caregivers association, the Iowa coalition of 31 home and community=based services for seniors, the <u>32 Iowa adult day services association</u>, the Iowa 33 association for home care, the Iowa council of health 34 care centers, the Iowa physician assistant society, 1 1 35 the Iowa association of nurse practitioners, the Iowa 36 nurse practitioner society, the Iowa occupational 37 therapy association, the Iowa association of homes and 1 1 38 services for the aging, the ARC of Iowa which was 1 39 formerly known as the association for retarded 40 citizens of Iowa, the alliance for the mentally ill of 41 Iowa, Iowa state association of counties, and the 1 1 42 governor's developmental disabilities council, 1 43 together with one person designated by the Iowa 44 chiropractic society; one state representative from 1 1 45 each of the two major political parties appointed by 46 the speaker of the house, one state senator from each 1 47 of the two major political parties appointed by the 48 president of the senate, after consultation with the 1 1 1 49 majority leader and the minority leader of the senate, 50 each for a term of two years; four public 1 representatives, appointed by the governor for 1 2 2 staggered terms of two years each, none of whom shall 3 be members of, or practitioners of, or have a 2 2 4 pecuniary interest in any of the professions or 5 businesses represented by any of the several 2 2 6 professional groups and associations specifically 2 7 represented on the council under this subsection, and 8 at least one of whom shall be a recipient of medical 2 2 9 assistance; the director of public health, or a 2 10 representative designated by the director; the 11 director of the department of elder affairs, or a 2 <u>12 representative designated by the director;</u> the dean of 13 Des Moines university == osteopathic medical center, 2 2 14 or a representative designated by the dean; and the 2 15 dean of the university of Iowa college of medicine, or 2 16 a representative designated by the dean. 17 The director shall consider the advice and 18 consultation offered by the council in the director's 2 2 19 preparation of medical assistance budget 20 recommendations to the council on human services 21 pursuant to section 217.3.> 2 2 22 2 23 2 24
