

# House Amendment 1504

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1 1 Amend Senate File 272, as passed by the Senate, as  
1 2 follows:  
1 3 #1. By striking everything after the enacting  
1 4 clause and inserting the following:  
1 5 <Section 1. Section 217.3, subsection 4, Code  
1 6 2005, is amended to read as follows:  
1 7 4. Approve the budget of the department of human  
1 8 services prior to submission to the governor. Prior  
1 9 to approval of the budget, the council shall publicize  
1 10 and hold a public hearing to provide explanations and  
1 11 hear questions, opinions, and suggestions regarding  
1 12 the budget. Invitations to the hearing shall be  
1 13 extended to the governor, the governor-elect, the  
1 14 director of the department of management, and other  
1 15 persons deemed by the council as integral to the  
1 16 budget process. The budget materials submitted to the  
1 17 governor shall include a review of options for  
1 18 revising the medical assistance program made available  
1 19 by federal action or by actions implemented by other  
1 20 states as identified by the department, the medical  
1 21 assistance advisory council and the executive  
~~1 22 committee of the medical assistance advisory council~~  
1 23 created in section ~~249A.4, subsection 8~~ 249A.4B, and  
1 24 by county representatives. The review shall address  
1 25 what potential revisions could be made in this state  
1 26 and how the changes would be beneficial to Iowans.  
1 27 Sec. 2. Section 249A.4, subsection 8, Code 2005,  
1 28 is amended by striking the subsection.  
1 29 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 249A.4B MEDICAL ASSISTANCE  
1 30 ADVISORY COUNCIL.  
1 31 1. A medical assistance advisory council is  
1 32 created to comply with 42 C.F.R. } 431.12 based on  
1 33 section 1902(a)(4) of the federal Social Security Act  
1 34 and to advise the director about health and medical  
1 35 care services under the medical assistance program.  
1 36 The council shall meet no more than quarterly. The  
1 37 director of public health shall serve as chairperson  
1 38 of the council.  
1 39 2. The council shall include all of the following  
1 40 members:  
1 41 a. The president, or the president's  
1 42 representative, of each of the following professional  
1 43 or business entities, or a member of each of the  
1 44 following professional or business entities, selected  
1 45 by the entity:  
1 46 (1) The Iowa medical society.  
1 47 (2) The Iowa osteopathic medical association.  
1 48 (3) The Iowa academy of family physicians.  
1 49 (4) The Iowa chapter of the American academy of  
1 50 pediatrics.  
2 1 (5) The Iowa physical therapy association.  
2 2 (6) The Iowa dental association.  
2 3 (7) The Iowa nurses association.  
2 4 (8) The Iowa pharmacy association.  
2 5 (9) The Iowa podiatric medical society.  
2 6 (10) The Iowa optometric association.  
2 7 (11) The Iowa association of community providers.  
2 8 (12) The Iowa psychological association.

2 40 (37) The alliance for the mentally ill of Iowa.  
2 41 (38) The Iowa state association of counties.  
2 42 (39) The governor's developmental disabilities  
2 43 council.  
2 44 (40) The Iowa chiropractic society.  
2 45 b. Public representatives which may include  
2 46 members of consumer groups, including recipients of  
2 47 medical assistance or their families, consumer  
2 48 organizations, and others, equal in number to the  
2 49 number of representatives of the professional and  
2 50 business entities specifically represented under  
3 1 paragraph "a", appointed by the governor for staggered  
3 2 terms of two years each, none of whom shall be members  
3 3 of, or practitioners of, or have a pecuniary interest  
3 4 in any of the professional or business entities  
3 5 specifically represented under paragraph "a", and a  
3 6 majority of whom shall be current or former recipients  
3 7 of medical assistance or members of the families of  
3 8 current or former recipients.  
3 9 c. The director of public health, or the  
3 10 director's designee.  
3 11 d. The director of the department of elder  
3 12 affairs, or the director's designee.  
3 13 e. The dean of Des Moines university ==  
3 14 osteopathic medical center, or the dean's designee.  
3 15 f. The dean of the university of Iowa college of  
3 16 medicine, or the dean's designee.  
3 17 g. The following members of the general assembly,  
3 18 each for a term of two years:  
3 19 (1) One member of the house of representatives  
3 20 from each of the two major political parties,  
3 21 appointed by the speaker of the house.  
3 22 (2) One member of the senate from each of the two  
3 23 major political parties, appointed by the president of  
3 24 the senate, after consultation with the majority  
3 25 leader and the minority leader of the senate.  
3 26 3. a. An executive committee of the council is  
3 27 created and shall consist of the following members of  
3 28 the council:  
3 29 (1) Five of the professional or business entity  
3 30 members designated pursuant to subsection 2, paragraph  
3 31 "a", and selected by the members specified under that  
3 32 paragraph.  
3 33 (2) Five of the public members appointed pursuant  
3 34 to subsection 2, paragraph "b", and selected by the  
3 35 members specified under that paragraph. Of the five  
3 36 public members, at least one member shall be a  
3 37 recipient of medical assistance.  
3 38 (3) The director of public health, or the  
3 39 director's designee.  
3 40 b. The executive committee shall meet on a monthly  
3 41 basis. The director of public health shall serve as  
3 42 chairperson of the executive committee.  
3 43 c. Based upon the deliberations of the council and  
3 44 the executive committee, the executive committee shall  
3 45 make recommendations to the director regarding the  
3 46 budget, policy, and administration of the medical  
3 47 assistance program.  
3 48 4. For each council meeting, other than those held  
3 49 during the time the general assembly is in session,  
3 50 each legislative member of the council shall be  
4 1 reimbursed for actual travel and other necessary  
4 2 expenses and shall receive a per diem as specified in  
4 3 section 7E.6 for each day in attendance, as shall the  
4 4 members of the council or the executive committee who  
4 5 are recipients or the family members of recipients of

4 6 medical assistance, regardless of whether the general  
4 7 assembly is in session.

4 8 5. The department shall provide staff support and  
4 9 independent technical assistance to the council and  
4 10 the executive committee.

4 11 6. The director shall consider the recommendations  
4 12 offered by the council and the executive committee in  
4 13 the director's preparation of medical assistance  
4 14 budget recommendations to the council on human  
4 15 services pursuant to section 217.3 and in  
4 16 implementation of medical assistance program policies.

4 17 Sec. 4. Section 249A.34, subsection 1, paragraph  
4 18 h, Code 2005, is amended to read as follows:

4 19 h. A representative of the medical assistance  
4 20 advisory council executive committee established  
4 21 pursuant to section ~~249A.4, subsection 8 249A.4B.>~~
