For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, sixty=five percent of the receipts shall be deposited 26 27 28 in the general fund, thirty percent of the receipts 29 shall be transferred to the housing trust fund, and 30 five percent of the receipts shall be transferred to 31 the shelter assistance fund. 1 32 <u>f. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010,</u> 33 sixty percent of the receipts shall be deposited in 34 the general fund, thirty=five percent of the receipts 35 shall be transferred to the housing trust fund, and 36 five percent of the receipts shall be transferred to 37 the shelter assistance fund. g. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011 38 39 fifty=five percent of the receipts shall be deposited 40 in the general fund, forty percent of the receipts 41 shall be transferred to the housing trust fund, and 42 five percent of the receipts shall be transferred to 43 the shelter assistance fund. h.
