1 2 reprinted by the House, as follows:
1 3 #1. Page 1, by inserting after line 11 the
1 4 following:
1 5 <In addition to the amount appropriated in this
1 6 subsection, the department is authorized to expend an
1 7 additional amount not to exceed \$359,560 for the
1 8 purposes designated in this subsection. Such amount
1 9 shall be expended from general fund moneys deposited
1 10 in revolving funds under the control of the department
1 11 that were appropriated to the department pursuant to
1 12 2004 Iowa Acts, chapter 1175, section 2. The
1 13 department shall develop a plan for repayment to the
1 14 general fund of the total amount appropriated to the
1 15 department for start-up funding for revolving funds
1 16 under the control of the department pursuant to 2004
1 17 Iowa Acts, chapter 1175, section 2. Any amount
1 18 expended pursuant to this paragraph shall be
1 19 considered a repayment amount to the general fund and
1 20 shall reduce the total amount to be repaid to the
1 21 general fund under the plan developed by the
1 22 department. The department shall submit the plan for
1 23 repayment to the department of management for
1 24 approval. Upon review and approval by the department
1 25 of management, the department of administrative
1 26 services shall submit the plan to the general assembly
1 27 for its review.>

2 37 RECEIVED.

2 38 All gifts, bequests, and grants received by a
2 39 department or accepted by the governor on behalf of
2 40 the state shall be reported to the Iowa ethics and
2 41 campaign disclosure board and the government oversight
2 42 committees. The ethics and campaign disclosure board
2 43 shall, by January 31 of each year, submit to the
2 44 fiscal services division of the legislative services
2 45 agency a written report listing all gifts, bequests,
2 46 and grants received during the previous calendar year
2 47 with a value over one thousand dollars and the purpose
2 48 for each such gift, bequest, or grant. The submission
2 49 shall also include a listing of all gifts, bequests,
2 50 and grants received by a department from a person if
3 1 the cumulative value of all gifts, bequests, and
3 2 grants received by the department from the person
3 3 during the previous calendar year exceeds one thousand
3 4 dollars, and the ethics and campaign disclosure board
3 5 shall include, if available, the purpose for each such
3 6 gift, bequest, or grant. However, reports on gifts,
3 7 grants, or bequests filed by the state board of
3 8 regents pursuant to section 8.44 shall be deemed
3 9 sufficient to comply with the requirements of this
3 10 section.>
