1 11 legs or the loss of a part of both legs thereof.

1 14 2. A person shall not operate or ride a snowmobile
1 15 with a firearm in the person's possession unless it is

1 27 or injury to the spinal cord, or ~~caused by an~~
1 28 individual who has suffered the loss of one or both
1 29 legs or the loss of a part of both legs thereof.>

1 33 2005, is amended to read as follows:
1 34 2. A person shall not operate or ride an all=
1 35 terrain vehicle with a firearm in the person's
1 36 possession unless it is unloaded and enclosed in a
1 37 carrying case. However, a nonambulatory person may
1 38 carry an uncased and loaded or unloaded firearm while
1 39 operating or riding an all-terrain vehicle.>

1 41 following:
1 42 <Sec. _____. Section 481A.120, Code 2005, is amended
1 43 by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof
1 44 the following:
1 45 481A.120 HUNTING FROM MOTORIZED VEHICLES OR
1 46 AIRCRAFT PROHIBITED == EXCEPTION.
1 47 1. A person, either singly or as one of a group of
1 48 persons, shall not intentionally kill or wound,
1 49 attempt to kill or wound, or pursue any animal, fowl,
1 50 or fish from or with an aircraft of any kind or a
2 1 motor-driven land conveyance on public or private
2 2 land.
2 3 2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, a nonambulatory
2 4 person may hunt game on public or private land from a
2 5 stationary motor-driven land conveyance, as provided
2 6 by the commission by rules adopted pursuant to chapter
2 7 17A. For the purposes of this subsection,
2 8 "nonambulatory person" means an individual with
2 9 paralysis of the lower half of the body with the
2 10 involvement of both legs, usually caused by disease of
2 11 or injury to the spinal cord, or an individual who has
2 12 suffered the loss of one or both legs or part thereof.
2 13 3. For the purposes of this section, a "motor=
2 14 driven land conveyance" includes but is not limited to
2 15 a motor vehicle as defined in section 321.1, an all=
2 16 terrain vehicle as defined in section 321I.1, and a
2 17 snowmobile as defined in section 321G.1.>
