1 1 Amend Senate File 2346, as amended, passed, and  
1 2 reprinted by the Senate, as follows:  
1 3 #1. Page 3, by striking lines 4 through 33.  
1 4 #2. Page 4, line 3, by striking the word <shall>  
1 5 and inserting the following: <may be required to>.  
1 6 #3. Page 4, line 7, by striking the words  
1 7 <required under this section>.  
1 8 #4. Page 4, lines 11 and 12, by striking the words  
1 9 <penalty, sanction, or educational requirement> and  
1 10 inserting the following: <penalty or sanction>.  
1 11 #5. Page 5, by striking lines 8 through 12 and  
1 12 inserting the following: <number of passenger safety  
1 13 belts.>  
1 14 #6. Page 6, line 23, by inserting after the word  
1 15 <bicycle,> the following: <or, if the driver of such  
1 16 motor vehicle is under eighteen years of age, the  
1 17 driver and all occupants of the vehicle>.  
1 18 #7. Page 6, line 26, by striking the words <eleven  
1 19 eighteen> and inserting the following: <eleven>.  
1 20 #8. Page 6, by inserting after line 27 the  
1 21 following:  
1 22 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321.445, subsection 2,  
1 23 paragraphs a, b, and f, Code 2005, are amended to read  
1 24 as follows:  
1 25 a. The driver or ~~front seat~~ occupants of a motor  
1 26 vehicle which is not required to be equipped with  
1 27 safety belts or safety harnesses.  
1 28 b. The driver and ~~front seat~~ occupants of a motor  
1 29 vehicle who are actively engaged in work which  
1 30 requires them to alight from and reenter the vehicle  
1 31 at frequent intervals, providing the vehicle does not  
1 32 exceed twenty-five miles per hour between stops.  
1 33 f. ~~Front seat occupants~~ Occupants of an authorized  
1 34 emergency vehicle while they are being transported in  
1 35 an emergency. However, this exemption does not apply  
1 36 to the driver of the authorized emergency vehicle.  
1 37 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321.445, subsections 3 and 5,  
1 38 Code 2005, are amended to read as follows:  
1 39 3. The driver and ~~front seat~~ passengers may be  
1 40 each charged separately for improperly used or nonused  
1 41 equipment under subsection 2. The owner of the motor  
1 42 vehicle may be charged for equipment violations under  
1 43 subsection 1.  
1 44 5. The department shall adopt rules pursuant to  
1 45 chapter 17A providing exceptions from application of  
1 46 subsections 1 and 2 for ~~front seats and front seat~~  
1 47 passengers of motor vehicles owned, leased, rented, or  
1 48 primarily used by persons with physical disabilities  
1 49 who use collapsible wheelchairs.>  
1 50 #9. By striking page 6, line 28, through page 7,  
2 1 line 1.  
2 2 #10. Page 7, by striking lines 2 through 15 and  
2 3 inserting the following:  
2 4 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. NEW SECTION. 321J.2C EDUCATION FOR  
2 5 PERSONS UNDER AGE TWENTY-ONE.  
2 6 Notwithstanding any other provision, a person under  
2 7 twenty-one years of age who operates a motor vehicle  
2 8 in violation of section 321J.2 or 321J.2A shall  
2 9 complete a course or program in accordance with the  
2 10 provisions of section 321J.22. In addition, the  
2 11 person may be required to complete a classroom course  
2 12 approved by the department consisting of behavior=  
2 13 based training designed to promote positive and safe  
2 14 decision making. The classroom course shall be the  
2 15 "alive at 25" course developed by the national safety  
2 16 council, or a course that contains equivalent  
2 17 curriculum and meets the goals of the "alive at 25"  
2 18 course.  
2 19 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321J.25, Code Supplement 2005,  
2 20 is repealed.>  
2 21 #11. Page 7, line 24, by inserting after the word  
2 22 <education.> the following: <In its review of driver  
2 23 education, the committee shall consider the value of  
2 24 current driver education curricula, potential matters

2 25 for inclusion in an approved driver education course,  
2 26 and requirements for hours of classroom and laboratory  
2 27 instruction.>  
2 28 #12. Page 8, by inserting after line 7, the  
2 29 following:  
2 30 <l. The Iowa state troopers association.>  
2 31 #13. Page 8, line 12, by inserting after the  
2 32 figure <2006.> the following: <In addition, the  
2 33 committee shall submit its recommendations concerning  
2 34 driver education in a proposal for legislation,  
2 35 presented in bill draft format, to the chairpersons of  
2 36 the house and senate standing committees on  
2 37 transportation, for consideration by the general  
2 38 assembly during the 2007 legislative session.>

2 40 figure <amending section 321.178 and>.  
2 41 #15. By renumbering as necessary.
