1 1 Amend Senate File 2352, as passed by the Senate, as  
1 2 follows:

1 3 #1. Page 1, by inserting after line 18 the  
1 4 following:

1 5 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321G.1, subsection 9, Code  
1 6 Supplement 2005, is amended to read as follows:

1 7 9. "Nonambulatory person" means an individual with  
1 8 paralysis of the lower half of the body with the  
1 9 involvement of both legs, usually caused by disease of  
1 10 or injury to the spinal cord, or ~~caused by an~~  
1 11 ~~individual who has suffered the loss of one or both~~  
1 12 ~~legs or the loss of a part of both legs thereof.~~

1 13 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321G.13, subsection 2, Code  
1 14 Supplement 2005, is amended to read as follows:

1 15 2. A person shall not operate or ride a snowmobile  
1 16 with a firearm in the person's possession unless it is  
1 17 unloaded and enclosed in a carrying case. However, a  
1 18 nonambulatory person may carry an uncased and loaded  
1 19 or unloaded firearm while operating or riding a  
1 20 snowmobile on land other than a street or highway.>

1 21 #2. Page 3, by inserting after line 1 the  
1 22 following:

1 23 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321I.1, subsection 8, Code  
1 24 2005, is amended to read as follows:

1 25 8. "Nonambulatory person" means an individual with  
1 26 paralysis of the lower half of the body with the  
1 27 involvement of both legs, usually caused by disease of  
1 28 or injury to the spinal cord, or ~~caused by an~~  
1 29 ~~individual who has suffered the loss of one or both~~  
1 30 ~~legs or the loss of a part of both legs thereof.~~>

1 31 #3. Page 7, by inserting after line 5 the  
1 32 following:

1 33 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321I.14, subsection 2, Code  
1 34 2005, is amended to read as follows:

1 35 2. A person shall not operate or ride an all=  
1 36 terrain vehicle with a firearm in the person's  
1 37 possession unless it is unloaded and enclosed in a  
1 38 carrying case. However, a nonambulatory person may  
1 39 carry an uncased and loaded or unloaded firearm while  
1 40 operating or riding an all-terrain vehicle on land  
1 41 other than a street or highway.>

1 42 #4. Page 9, by inserting after line 32 the  
1 43 following:

1 44 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 481A.120, Code 2005, is amended  
1 45 by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof  
1 46 the following:

1 47 481A.120 HUNTING FROM MOTORIZED VEHICLES OR  
1 48 AIRCRAFT PROHIBITED == EXCEPTION.

1 49 1. A person, either singly or as one of a group of  
1 50 persons, shall not intentionally kill or wound,  
2 1 attempt to kill or wound, or pursue any animal, fowl,  
2 2 or fish from or with an aircraft of any kind or a  
2 3 motor-driven land conveyance on public or private  
2 4 land.

2 5 2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, a nonambulatory  
2 6 person may hunt game on public or private land, other  
2 7 than a street or highway, from a stationary motor=  
2 8 driven land conveyance, as provided by the commission  
2 9 by rules adopted pursuant to chapter 17A. For the  
2 10 purposes of this subsection, the following definitions  
2 11 apply:

2 12 a. "Nonambulatory person" means an individual with  
2 13 paralysis of the lower half of the body with the  
2 14 involvement of both legs, usually caused by disease of  
2 15 or injury to the spinal cord, or an individual who has  
2 16 suffered the loss of one or both legs or part thereof.

2 17 b. "Street" or "highway" means the entire width  
2 18 between property lines of every way or place of  
2 19 whatever nature when any part thereof is open to the  
2 20 use of the public, as a matter of right, for purposes  
2 21 of vehicular travel, except in public areas in which  
2 22 the boundary shall be thirty-three feet each side of  
2 23 the center line of the roadway.

2 24 3. For the purposes of this section, a "motor="

2 25 driven land conveyance" includes but is not limited to  
2 26 a motor vehicle as defined in section 321.1, an all=  
2 27 terrain vehicle as defined in section 321I.1, an all=  
2 28 terrain utility vehicle as defined in section 321I.1,  
2 29 and a snowmobile as defined in section 321G.1.>  
2 30 #5. Title page, line 1, by striking the words <of  
2 31 all=terrain> and inserting the following: <and use of  
2 32 certain>.  
2 33 #6. Title page, line 1, by inserting after the  
2 34 word <vehicles,> the following: <including the  
2 35 possession of and use of firearms while riding on  
2 36 certain motorized vehicles,>.  
2 37 #7. By renumbering as necessary.
