1 1 Amend House File 2782 as follows:  
1 2 #1. Page 28, by inserting after line 13 the  
1 3 following:

1 6 Sec. \_\_\_\_ NEW SECTION. 8A.330 STATE BUILDING  
1 7 WELLNESS FACILITIES.  
1 8 1. For the purposes of this section:  
1 9 a. "State business space" means a building or  
1 10 portion of a building occupied by persons conducting  
1 11 state business.  
1 12 b. "Wellness facilities" means space dedicated for  
1 13 exercise equipment, shower and changing facilities,  
1 14 the provision of physical fitness and health promotion  
1 15 classes, and other programs and facilities intended to  
1 16 support persons engaged in healthy lifestyle  
1 17 activities.  
1 18 2. The general assembly finds that a healthy  
1 19 workforce is essential to efficiently provide service  
1 20 to the public and that state employees should be  
1 21 supported in their efforts to maintain a healthy  
1 22 lifestyle. In order to support these efforts, state=  
1 23 owned wellness facilities should be provided within or  
1 24 in close proximity to state business space.  
1 25 3. State business space that is constructed on or  
1 26 after July 1, 2007, shall provide the employees using  
1 27 that space with access to wellness facilities. Unless  
1 28 state-owned wellness facilities are already available  
1 29 in close proximity to the state business space, the  
1 30 department, state agency contracting officer, and  
1 31 director of the state agency that will occupy the  
1 32 business space shall ensure that the architect or  
1 33 other person responsible for developing plans and  
1 34 specifications for the space includes plans and  
1 35 specifications for wellness facilities within the  
1 36 state business space. The cost of the wellness  
1 37 facilities shall not exceed one-half of one percent of  
1 38 the total cost of the state business space, exclusive  
1 39 of professional fees associated with development of  
1 40 the wellness facilities.  
1 41 4. A wellness facility developed in accordance  
1 42 with this section shall be administered by the  
1 43 department in accordance with the needs of the agency  
1 44 occupying the state business space in which the  
1 45 wellness facility is located.>
