1 1 Amend House File 2797 as follows:  
1 2 #1. Page 45, by inserting after line 31 the  
1 3 following:  
1 4 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 483A.8, subsection 1, Code  
1 5 Supplement 2005, is amended to read as follows:  
1 6 1. A resident hunting deer who is required to have  
1 7 a hunting license must have a resident hunting license  
1 8 in addition to the deer hunting license and must pay  
1 9 the wildlife habitat fee. In addition, a resident who  
1 10 purchases a deer hunting license shall pay a one  
1 11 dollar fee that shall be used and is appropriated for  
1 12 the purpose of deer herd population management,  
1 13 including assisting with the cost of processing deer  
1 14 donated to the help us stop hunger program  
1 15 administered by the commission. The deer herd  
1 16 population management fees collected pursuant to this  
1 17 subsection shall not be used to assist with the cost  
1 18 of processing deer for use by the department of  
1 19 corrections.  
1 20 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 483A.8, subsection 3, paragraph  
1 21 a, Code Supplement 2005, is amended to read as  
1 22 follows:  
1 23 a. A nonresident hunting deer is required to have  
1 24 a nonresident hunting license and a nonresident deer  
1 25 license and must pay the wildlife habitat fee. In  
1 26 addition, a nonresident who purchases a deer hunting  
1 27 license shall pay a one dollar fee that shall be used  
1 28 and is appropriated for the purpose of deer herd  
1 29 population management, including assisting with the  
1 30 cost of processing deer donated to the help us stop  
1 31 hunger program administered by the commission. The  
1 32 deer herd population management fees collected  
1 33 pursuant to this paragraph shall not be used to assist  
1 34 with the cost of processing deer for use by the  
1 35 department of corrections.  
1 36 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 483A.24, subsection 2, paragraph  
1 37 c, Code Supplement 2005, is amended to read as  
1 38 follows:  
1 39 c. Upon written application on forms furnished by  
1 40 the department, the department shall issue annually  
1 41 without fee two deer hunting licenses, one antlered or  
1 42 any sex deer hunting license and one antlerless deer  
1 43 only deer hunting license, to the owner of a farm unit  
1 44 or a member of the owner's family, but only a total of  
1 45 two licenses for both, and to the tenant of a farm  
1 46 unit or a member of the tenant's family, but only a  
1 47 total of two licenses for both. The deer hunting  
1 48 licenses issued shall be valid only for use on the  
1 49 farm unit for which the applicant applies pursuant to  
1 50 this paragraph. The owner or the tenant need not  
2 1 reside on the farm unit to qualify for the free deer  
2 2 hunting licenses to hunt on that farm unit. The free  
2 3 deer hunting licenses issued pursuant to this  
2 4 paragraph shall be valid and may be used during any  
2 5 shotgun deer season. The licenses may be used to  
2 6 harvest deer in two different seasons. In addition, a  
2 7 person who receives a free deer hunting license  
2 8 pursuant to this paragraph shall pay a one dollar fee  
2 9 for each license that shall be used and is  
2 10 appropriated for the purpose of deer herd population  
2 11 management, including assisting with the cost of  
2 12 processing deer donated to the help us stop hunger  
2 13 program administered by the commission. The deer herd  
2 14 population management fees collected pursuant to this  
2 15 paragraph shall not be used to assist with the cost of  
2 16 processing deer for use by the department of  
2 17 corrections.>
