PRECURSORS TO AMPHETAMINE AND METHAMPHETAMINE. 8 9 Unless specifically excepted in paragraph "d" or 1 10 listed in another schedule, any material, compound, 1 11 mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity of 1 1 12 the following precursors to amphetamine or 13 methamphetamine, including their salts, optical 14 isomers, and salts of their optical isomers: 1 1 1 15 a. Ephedrine. 1 16 b. Phenylpropanolamine. 17 c. Pseudoephedrine.
