1 1 Amend Senate File 342 as follows:
1 2 #1. Page 9, by inserting before line 1 the
1 3 following:

1 5 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS
1 6 Sec. _____. 2003 Iowa Acts, chapter 179, section 21,
1 7 subsections 2 and 5, as enacted by 2005 Iowa Acts,
1 8 Senate File 75, section 1, are amended to read as
1 9 follows:
1 10 2. Of the funds appropriated in this section,
1 11 \$10,000 is transferred to the ~~Iowa~~ department of
1 12 ~~public health~~ human services for allocation to
1 13 community mental health centers to provide counseling
1 14 services to persons, whether or not employed by the
1 15 state, who are members of the national guard or
1 16 reservists and who are assigned to active duty service
1 17 in the armed forces of the United States and to the
1 18 persons' family members. The sessions shall be
1 19 provided on a first come, first served basis and shall
1 20 be limited to three visits per family.
1 21 5. The remainder of the funds appropriated in this
1 22 section are transferred to the Iowa finance authority
1 23 to be used for a home ownership assistance program for
1 24 persons who are eligible members of the armed forces
1 25 of the United States. In the event an eligible member
1 26 is deceased, the surviving spouse of the eligible
1 27 member shall be eligible for a loan under the program,
1 28 subject to the surviving spouse meeting the program's
1 29 eligibility requirements other than the military
1 30 service requirement. For the purposes of this
1 31 subsection, "eligible member of the armed forces of
1 32 the United States" means a resident of this state who
1 33 is or was a member of the national guard, reserve, or
1 34 regular component of the armed forces of the United
1 35 States who has served at least ninety days of active
1 36 duty service during the period beginning September 11,
1 37 2001, and ending June 30, 2006.

1 39 Act is retroactively applicable to May 17, 2004.>
