  9 excluding superintendents, assistant superintendents, 10 principals, and assistant principals, shall be in 11 writing and shall state the number of contract days,
  12 the annual compensation to be paid, and any other
  13 matters as may be mutually agreed upon. The contract 14 may include employment for a term not exceeding the
1 15 ensuing school year, except as otherwise authorized.
         b. Prior to entering into an initial contract with teacher who holds a license other than an initial

  18 license issued by the board of educational examiners 19 under chapter 272, the school district shall request
  20 the division of criminal investigation of the
  21 department of public safety to conduct a background
  22 investigation of the applicant. The school district
  23 shall require the teacher to submit a completed 24 fingerprint packet, which shall be used to facilitate
  25 a national criminal history check. The school
  26 district shall submit the packet to the division of 27 criminal investigation of the department of public
  28 safety which shall conduct a thorough background
  29 investigation of the teacher. The superintendent
   30 school district or the superintendent's designee shall
  31 have access to and shall review the sex offender
  32 registry information under section 692A.13, the 33 central registry for child abuse information 34 established under section 235A.14, and the central
