The director of a department or state agency to 1 11 which appropriations are made pursuant to the 12 provisions of this Act shall assess the extent to 1 13 which job classifications or individual employment 14 positions with the department or agency might be 1 1 1 15 effectively performed from an employee's residence or 16 other remote location through telecommuting, thereby 17 increasing office space within the department or 1 1 1 18 agency and reducing administrative costs. The 1 19 assessment shall include an estimate of the number of 20 department or agency employees whose job 21 responsibilities could be effectively performed on a 1 1 22 telecommuting basis, projected costs of establishing 23 and maintaining work stations at an employee's 1 1 24 residence or other remote location and providing 1 25 telecommuter support, anticipated savings to the 26 department or agency through a reduction in the 1 1 27 office=based workforce, and anticipated time and cost 1 28 savings to telecommuting employees. A report 1 29 summarizing the assessment shall be submitted to the 30 director of the department of administrative services, 31 and the members of the general assembly, by November 1 1 1 1 32 1, 2007. 1 33 2. Based on the assessment conducted pursuant to 1 34 subsection 1, the director shall develop a 1 35 telecommuter employment policy for the department or 36 agency and a timeline for initial policy 1 37 implementation and plans for expanding the number of 1 38 telecommuting employees. Specific office=based 1 1 39 workforce reduction percentages shall be left to the 1 40 discretion of the director, but the director shall 41 implement a policy by January 1, 2008. The director 42 shall report to the director of the department of 1 1 43 administrative services and the members of the general 44 assembly on an annual basis beginning January 1, 2009, 1 1 45 the number of telecommuting employees, cost savings 1 46 achieved by the department or agency, and plans for 1 1 47 continued transfer of office=based employees to 1 48 telecommuter status.> 1 49 <u>#3.</u> By renumbering as necessary. 1 50 HF 874.S 1 ec/cc/26 2
