1 12 Sec. \_\_\_\_ LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS COMMITTEE.  
1 13 1. There is established a local government  
1 14 elections committee. The committee shall study the  
1 15 following issues:  
1 16 a. Specified dates of special elections for  
1 17 counties, cities, school districts, and community  
1 18 colleges.  
1 19 b. The length of terms of office of school  
1 20 district boards of directors and community college  
1 21 boards of directors.  
1 22 2. The local government elections committee shall  
1 23 be comprised of the following members:  
1 24 a. The secretary of state.  
1 25 b. Two county auditors appointed by the Iowa state  
1 26 association of counties.  
1 27 c. Two representatives of cities appointed by the  
1 28 Iowa league of cities.  
1 29 d. Two representatives of school districts  
1 30 appointed by the Iowa association of school boards.  
1 31 e. Two representatives of community colleges  
1 32 appointed by the Iowa association of community college  
1 33 trustees.  
1 34 f. Two members of the house of representatives,  
1 35 one appointed by the speaker of the house of  
1 36 representatives and one appointed by the minority  
1 37 leader of the house of representatives.  
1 38 g. Two members of the senate, one appointed by the  
1 39 majority leader of the senate and one appointed by the  
1 40 minority leader of the senate.  
1 41 3. The secretary of state shall serve as  
1 42 chairperson of the committee. Staffing assistance  
1 43 shall be provided to the committee by the office of  
1 44 secretary of state. Meetings of the committee shall  
1 45 be at the call of the chairperson.  
1 46 4. The local government elections committee shall  
1 47 report to the general assembly no later than January  
1 48 15, 2009. The report shall contain findings and  
1 49 recommendations related to the issues described in  
1 50 subsection 1.>
