A state 2 15 employee on an annual salary shall not be paid for a 2 16 pay period an amount which exceeds the employee's 17 annual salary transposed into a rate applicable to the 18 pay period by dividing the annual salary by the number 2 2 19 of pay periods in the fiscal year. Salaries for state 2 20 employees covered by the overtime payment provisions 2 21 of the federal Fair Labor Standards Act shall be 2 22 established on an hourly basis. In addition, unless <u>23 otherwise authorized by law or required pursuant to a</u> 2 24 collective bargaining agreement, a state employee

shall not, in addition to a salary, receive any 26 remuneration in the form of a bonus, including but not 27 limited to a retention bonus, recruitment bonus, 28 exceptional job performance pay, extraordinary duty 29 pay, or extraordinary or special duty pay, for or 2 30 during the time period beginning on or after the 31 effective date of this Act. APPOINTED STATE OFFICERS. The governor 2 32 Sec. _ 2 33 shall establish a salary for appointed nonelected 34 persons in the executive branch of state government 2 2 35 holding a position authorized by a law that addresses 2 36 the salary ranges of state officers within the range 2 37 provided, by considering, among other items, the 38 experience of the individual in the position, changes 2 39 in the duties of the position, the incumbent's 2 2 40 performance of assigned duties, and subordinates' 41 salaries. However, the attorney general shall 42 establish the salary for the consumer advocate, 2 2 the 2 43 chief justice of the supreme court shall establish the 44 salary for the state court administrator, the ethics 2 2 45 and campaign disclosure board shall establish the 46 salary of the executive director, the Iowa public 2 2 47 broadcasting board shall establish the salary of the 48 administrator of the public broadcasting division of 49 the department of education, and the state fair board 2 2 50 shall establish the salary of the secretary of the 2 1 state fair board, each within the salary range 2 authorized by a law that addresses the salary ranges 3 3 3 of state officers. 3 4 The governor, in establishing salaries as 5 authorized by a law that addresses the salary ranges 6 of state officers, shall take into consideration other 3 3 3 3 7 employee benefits which may be provided for an 3 8 individual including but not limited to housing.
