A state 1 1 49 employee on an annual salary shall not be paid for a 50 pay period an amount which exceeds the employee's 1 annual salary transposed into a rate applicable to the 1 2 2 pay period by dividing the annual salary by the number 3 of pay periods in the fiscal year.
