1 20 a. The board may deny a license to or revoke the
1 21 license of a person upon the board's finding by a
1 22 preponderance of evidence that either the person has
1 23 been convicted of a crime or that there has been a
1 24 founded report of child abuse against the person.
1 25 Rules adopted in accordance with this paragraph shall
1 26 provide that in determining whether a person should be
1 27 denied a license or that a practitioner's license
1 28 should be revoked, the board shall consider the nature
1 29 and seriousness of the founded abuse or crime in
1 30 relation to the position sought, the time elapsed
1 31 since the crime was committed, the degree of
1 32 rehabilitation which has taken place since the
1 33 incidence of founded abuse or the commission of the
1 34 crime, the likelihood that the person will commit the
1 35 same abuse or crime again, and the number of founded
1 36 abuses committed by or criminal convictions of the
1 37 person involved. In addition, the board may revoke
1 38 the license of a person upon the board's finding by a
1 39 preponderance of the evidence that the person failed
1 40 to report an arrest as provided in section 280.29.>

1 45 1. A school employee who has been arrested for a
1 46 criminal offense shall report the arrest to the board
1 47 of educational examiners within seven days of the
1 48 arrest. A school employee who is not licensed or
1 49 certified by the board of educational examiners, or
1 50 who does not have a statement of professional
2 1 recognition issued by the board of educational
2 2 examiners, shall report the arrest to the principal of
2 3 the school within seven days of the arrest.
2 4 2. When an arrest is reported pursuant to
2 5 subsection 1, the board of educational examiners or
2 6 the principal of the school who received the report
2 7 shall notify the department of education and the
2 8 department shall proceed as provided in section
2 9 256.11, subsection 10, paragraph b, subparagraph (1),
2 10 subparagraph subdivision (f).

2 12 disciplinary action pursuant to section 272.2,
2 13 subsection 14, paragraph "a.">>
