following:
<Sec. Section 20.29, Code 2007, is amended by
adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:
NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH: Within ninety days of
the completion of a collective bargaining agreement
entered into pursuant to this chapter, the public
employer shall file two copies of the' agreement with
the board. In addition, within the same time period,
the public employer and the applicable certified
employee organization shall file with the board,
either jointly or separately, a report on a form
prescribed by the board which shall include the number
of employees covered by the agreement, the estimated
cost of implementing each wage, benefit, and other
provision of the agreement having an economic impact
and the estimated percentage increase in cost for each
item compared to the prior agreement, the estimated
total cost of implementing the agreement for the
entire term of the agreement, and any other
information relating to the agreement as requested by
the board.>
