hundred thousand dollars.

fifty thousand, an amount up to four hundred thousand
dollars.
    (c) For a county with a population greater than
fifty thousand but not more than one hundred thousand,
an amount up to two hundred fifty thousand dollars.
    (d) For a county with a population greater than
twenty=six thousand but not more than fifty thousand,
an amount up to one hundred thousand dollars.
    (e) For a county with a population greater than
fifteen thousand but not more than twenty=six
thousand, an amount up to fifty thousand dollars.
    (f) For a county with a population equal to or
less than fifteen thousand, an amount up to
twenty=five thousand dollars.>
#2.. Page 20, by inserting after line 34 the
following:
    < (1) A county may enter into an agreement
pursuant to chapter 28E with one or more other
counties for the purpose of collecting delinquent
court debt pursuant to this subsection.
    (2) Notwithstanding paragraph "c", if a county
subject to the threshold amount in paragraph "c",
subparagraph (2), subparagraph subdivision (e) or (f)
enters into such an agreement exclusively with a
county or counties subject to the threshold amount in
paragraph "c", subparagraph (2), subparagraph
subdivision (e) or (f), the threshold amount
applicable to all of the counties combined shall be a
single threshold amount, equal to the threshold amount
attributable to the county with the largest
population.>
