=JOB EVAL $\overline{U A T I O N}$ AND CLASSIFICATION STUDY.

1. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010, the department of administrative services shall conduct a job evaluation study of state employees for the purpose of determining whether the
job classification and pay grade level of selected
state employees are properly determined.
2. In conducting the study, the department shall provide a job evaluation questionnaire to a randomly selected sample of state employees within particular
job classifications. The department shall examine each questionnaire and determine, based upon an evaluation system established by the department,
whether the particular state employee is properly
classified and assigned an appropriate pay grade. If
the department makes an initial determination that the state employee is improperly classified, the
department shall allow the employer of the state
employee a reasonable opportunity to respond to the
alleged misclassification. If the department makes a
final determination that the state employee is
misclassified, the department shall direct the
employer of the state employee, within fourteen days
of the determination by the department, to properly
classify the state employee within the proper job
classification and pay grade.>
