Amend the amendment, H-8430, to Senate File 2370, 2 as amended, passed, and reprinted by the Senate, as 3 follows:

4 l. Page 1, by striking line 7 and inserting  $5 \cdot 10 \cdot 08$  or more.

6 < Sec. \_\_\_. Section 462A.14, Code 2009, is amended 7 by adding the following new subsections:

8 NEW SUBSECTION. 14. A peace officer may stop or 9 detain a motorboat or sailboat upon a reasonable and 10 specific belief that a violation has occurred during 11 the operation of the motorboat or sailboat. The 12 reasonable and specific belief that a violation has 13 occurred must be observed by the peace officer prior to 14 the time of the stop or detention of the motorboat or 15 sailboat and must be the reason for the peace officer 16 to stop or detain the motorboat or sailboat.

NEW SUBSECTION. 15. For the purposes of this section, "operate" means to be in actual physical control of a motorboat which is powered by a motor of ten horsepower or more and which is moving at a speed great enough to cause a wake or to be in actual physical control of a sailboat in motion which is under a sail speed great enough to cause a wake.>
