1 10 <Sec. _____. OFFICE EXPENSES == MANDATORY REDUCTION.
1 11 For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending
1 12 June 30, 2010, the appropriations from the general
1 13 fund of the state to a state department or state
1 14 agency to which appropriations are made pursuant to
1 15 this Act are reduced by such amount, as necessary to
1 16 effect a 50 percent reduction in the amount
1 17 appropriated for expenditures for office supplies,
1 18 service contracts, and equipment purchases. The
1 19 reduction of the individual appropriations shall be
1 20 determined by the department of management in
1 21 consultation with the affected departments and
1 22 agencies on the basis of the expected expenditures for
1 23 such items by the affected state department or agency
1 24 for the fiscal year without the reduction required by
1 25 this section. The specific amount that each
1 26 individual appropriation is reduced shall be outlined
1 27 in a memorandum prepared by the department of
1 28 management which shall be submitted to the general
1 29 assembly and legislative services agency within 30
1 30 days of the effective date of this section of this
1 31 Act. The reduction of an individual appropriation
1 32 pursuant to this section shall be applied prior to any
1 33 reductions in full-time equivalent positions. The
1 34 reduction of an individual appropriation pursuant to
1 35 this section shall be in addition to any other
1 36 reduction required by law and general fund
1 37 appropriations reduced pursuant to this section shall
1 38 not be expended for any other purposes but shall be
1 39 retained in the general fund of the state.>

1 42 <Sec. _____. VACANT, FUNDED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT
1 43 POSITIONS. Notwithstanding any provision to the
1 44 contrary, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009,
1 45 and ending June 30, 2010, the director of a department
1 46 or state agency to which appropriations are made
1 47 pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall revert to
1 48 the general fund of the state at the close of the
1 49 fiscal year an amount equal to the salary and benefits
1 50 cost of each full-time equivalent position funded with
2 1 an appropriation made in this Act that remains vacant
2 2 for a period of six months or more.>
2 3 #6. Page 60, by inserting before line 32 the
2 4 following:
2 5 <Sec. _____. EXPENDITURES FOR CELLULAR TELEPHONES
2 6 AND PERSONAL DIGITAL ASSISTANTS PROHIBITED.
2 7 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, other
2 8 than for employees performing inspections or who are
2 9 otherwise normally performing their primary duties
2 10 away from a fixed location more than 70 percent of the
2 11 time, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, a
2 12 department receiving appropriations in this Act shall
2 13 not expend moneys appropriated from the general fund
2 14 of the state to pay for or reimburse the initial or
2 15 associated service costs for cellular telephones,
2 16 personal digital assistant devices, or handheld
2 17 computers. However, the executive council may
2 18 authorize an exception on a case-by-case basis, to
2 19 address an emergency situation for a period of time
2 20 not more than three consecutive calendar months in
2 21 length or to complete the minimum period specified
2 22 under the terms of a lease or contract.>

2 36 VEHICLE PURCHASES

2 37 Sec. ____ VEHICLE PURCHASES DEFERRED.
2 38 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, except
2 39 as otherwise provided by this section, the department
2 40 of administrative services shall defer the purchase of
2 41 replacement motor vehicles paid for from the general
2 42 fund of the state or from such moneys credited to the
2 43 depreciation fund maintained pursuant to section
2 44 8A.365. The purchase deferral is applicable to the
2 45 remainder of the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008,
2 46 commencing on the effective date of this section and
2 47 to the succeeding fiscal year. However, the executive
2 48 council may authorize an exception to allow purchase
2 49 of a replacement vehicle when the purchase is less
2 50 costly than all other alternatives.
