Amend Senate File 534, as passed by the Senate, as follows:

- 3 l. By striking everything after the enacting clause 4 and inserting:
- 5 <Section 1. Section 707.7, subsections 1, 2, and 4, 6 Code 2011, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 1. Any person who intentionally terminates a human 8 pregnancy, with the knowledge and voluntary consent 9 of the pregnant person, after the end of the second 10 trimester of the pregnancy a gestation period of 11 twenty completed weeks where death of the fetus results
- 12 commits feticide. Feticide is a class "C" felony.

 13 2. Any person who attempts to intentionally
- 14 terminate a human pregnancy, with the knowledge and
 15 voluntary consent of the pregnant person, after the end
 16 of the second trimester of the pregnancy a gestation
 17 period of twenty completed weeks where death of the
 18 fetus does not result commits attempted feticide.
- 19 Attempted feticide is a class "D" felony.
- 4. This section shall not apply to the termination of a human pregnancy performed by a physician licensed in this state to practice medicine or surgery or osteopathic medicine or surgery when in the best clinical judgment of the physician the termination is performed to preserve the life or health of the pregnant person or of the fetus and every reasonable medical effort not inconsistent with preserving the life of the pregnant person is made to preserve the life of a viable the fetus.
- 30 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being 31 deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon 32 enactment.>
