STUDY - PRESCRIPTION DRUG OR 4 5 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE MEDICATION DEFENSE IN 6 OPERATING-WHILE-INTOXICATED CASES. The legislative 7 council is requested to establish an interim study 8 committee to review the provisions of Code section 9 321J.2, subsection 11, relating to the prescription 10 drug or controlled substance medication defense in 11 a criminal operating-while-intoxicated case and to 12 consider the application of such a defense in an 13 administrative license revocation proceeding based on 14 an operating-while-intoxicated offense. Committee 15 discussion shall include but not be limited to 16 whether the prescription drug or controlled substance 17 medication defense should be confined to criminal 18 operating-while-intoxicated cases, whether the 19 prescription drug or controlled substance medication 20 defense should be included in an implied consent 21 warning, and if so, what type of medical warning about 22 the use of the prescription medication and driving 23 should be required. The committee shall include at 24 least four members of the general assembly and persons 25 with expertise in operating-while-intoxicated cases 26 including representatives from the department of 27 transportation, the department of justice, prosecution 28 and defense counsel, and the medical community 29 including a representative from the pharmacy community. 30 The study committee shall issue a report to the general 31 assembly containing its findings and recommendations 32 by January 15, 2014.> Title page, line 1, after <Act> by inserting 33 2. 34 <creating a study>
