For personnel settlement agreements with an 26 employee of an executive branch employer, excluding an 27 employee of the state board of regents or institution 28 under the control of the state board of regents, 29 the personnel settlement agreement shall, to the 30 extent consistent with any provision of an applicable 31 collective bargaining agreement, be reviewed and 32 approved as to form by the attorney general or by 33 the attorney general's designee, and approved by the 34 director of the department of management, the director 35 of the department of administrative services, and the 36 head of the agency or office involved with the matter 37 at issue. 38 b. For personnel settlement agreements with an 39 employee of the state board of regents or institution 40 under the control of the state board of regents, 41 the personnel settlement agreement shall, to the 42 extent consistent with any provision of an applicable 43 collective bargaining agreement, be reviewed and 44 approved as to form by the attorney general or by 45 the attorney general's designee, and approved by the 46 executive director of the state board of regents and 47 the head of the institution involved with the matter 48 at issue. c.
