4 <Sec. _____. VETERANS.

5 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of
6 the state to the department of workforce development
7 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, and
8 ending June 30, 2015, the following amount, or so much
9 thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes
10 designated:

11 For funding research linking military occupational
12 education, training, and service to existing licensing
13 requirements in this state, for funding implementation
14 of this Act, and for meeting additional demand for
15 workforce development services provided to veterans:
16 \$ 1,000,000

17 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of
18 the state to the department of workforce development
19 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, and
20 ending June 30, 2015, the following amount, or so much
21 thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes
22 designated:

23 For awarding a grant, in the amount appropriated,
24 to a nonprofit workforce services foundation exempt
25 from federal taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the
26 Internal Revenue Code that is administered by an agency
27 of this state for the purposes of paying for the direct
28 expenses of marketing this state to veterans through
29 public-private partnerships:
