453A.56 Uniform Implementation, application, and 9 enforcement.

- 10 1. Enforcement of this chapter relating to 11 cigarettes and tobacco products shall be implemented 12 in an equitable manner throughout the state. For 13 the purpose of equitable and uniform implementation, 14 application, and enforcement of state and local 15 laws and regulations, the provisions of this chapter 16 relating to cigarettes and tobacco products shall 17 supersede any local law or regulation which is 18 inconsistent with or conflicts with the provisions 19 of this chapter relating to cigarettes or tobacco 20 products.
- 2. For the purposes of implementation, application, 22 and enforcement of this chapter relating to vapor 23 products and alternative nicotine products, nothing 24 in this chapter shall be construed to supersede the 25 jurisdiction of any city, county, township, school 26 district, or other political subdivision to adopt and 27 enforce any local law or regulation relating to vapor 28 products or alternative nicotine products that is 29 at least as restrictive as those imposed under this 30 chapter relating to vapor products or alternative 31 nicotine products.>>
