- 1 Amend Senate File 2360, as passed by the Senate, as  
2 follows:
- 3 1. By striking page 4, line 33, through page 5,  
4 line 6.
- 5 2. Page 6, by striking lines 6 through 9 and  
6 inserting:
- 7 <*b.* The rules adopted pursuant to this subsection  
8 shall include but not be limited to rules to establish  
9 all of the following:
- 10 (1) Rules to establish the manner in which the  
11 department shall consider applications for new and  
12 renewal cannabidiol registration cards.
- 13 (2) Rules to establish the manner in which  
14 an out-of-state patient who possesses a written  
15 recommendation of a treating neurologist that  
16 specifically allows the patient to possess or  
17 use cannabidiol to treat or alleviate symptoms of  
18 intractable epilepsy in the jurisdiction of issuance  
19 shall apply for and may be issued a temporary  
20 cannabidiol registration card.>
- 21 3. Page 7, after line 16 by inserting:
- 22 <*0c.* (1) The defenses afforded a patient under  
23 paragraph "*a*" apply to a patient only if the quantity  
24 of cannabidiol oil possessed by the patient does not  
25 exceed thirty-two ounces.
- 26 (2) The defenses afforded a primary caregiver  
27 under paragraph "*b*" apply to a primary caregiver only  
28 if the quantity of cannabidiol oil possessed by the  
29 primary caregiver does not exceed thirty-two ounces per  
30 patient.>
- 31 4. Page 7, after line 33 by inserting:
- 32 <Sec. \_\_\_\_ . STUDY. The university of Iowa school  
33 of medicine shall establish and conduct a clinical  
34 research study to determine the outcomes and results  
35 of cannabidiol on patients diagnosed with intractable  
36 epilepsy. The university shall submit its findings and  
37 recommendations to the department of public health and  
38 the general assembly on or before July 1, 2017.>
- 39 5. By renumbering as necessary.
