6. Page l3, after line 21 by inserting:
<Sec. $\qquad$ - EMERGENCY RULES. The department of education and the college student aid commission may adopt emergency rules under section l7A.4, subsection 3 , and section 17A.5, subsection 2, paragraph "b", to implement the provisions of this division of this Act and the rules shall be effective immediately upon filing unless a later date is specified in the rules. Any rules adopted in accordance with this section shall also be published as a notice of intended action as provided in section 17A. 4.

Sec. $\qquad$ - EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. Unless otherwise provided, this division of this Act, if approved by the governor on or after July 1,2020 , takes effect upon enactment.

Sec. $\qquad$ - RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. Unless otherwise provided, this division of this Act, if approved by the governor on or after July l, 2020, applies retroactively to July l, 2020.>
