The period of 13 time so advanced shall be known as "daylight saving time". 14 Sec. 2. Section 714G.1, subsection 6, Code 2023, is amended 15 to read as follows: 16 6. "Normal business hours" means Sunday through Saturday, 17 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:30 p.m., central standard 18 time or central daylight saving time.> 2.
