- 1 Amend House File 2639 as follows:
- 2 1. Page 2, after line 20 by inserting:
- 3 <Sec. ___. Section 321.34, Code 2024, is amended by adding
- 4 the following new subsection:
- 5 NEW SUBSECTION. 11F. Endangered species plates.
- 6 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the
- 7 director may issue endangered species plates to the owner of a
- 8 motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109,
- 9 subsection 1, autocycle, motor truck, motor home, multipurpose
- 10 vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer.
- 11 b. Endangered species plates shall be designed by the
- 12 department. The background shall be green and the plate's
- 13 numbers and letters shall be white. The left side of the plate
- 14 shall depict an image of a turtle. The phrase "Don't Tread On
- 15 Me" shall appear at the bottom of the plate.
- 16 c. The special endangered species fee for letter-number
- 17 designated endangered species plates is thirty-five dollars.
- 18 An applicant may obtain personalized endangered species plates
- 19 upon payment of the fee for personalized plates as provided in
- 20 subsection 5, which is in addition to the special endangered
- 21 species fee.
- 22 d. The fees collected by the director under this subsection
- 23 shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and deposited
- 24 in the road use tax fund. The treasurer of state shall
- 25 transfer monthly from the statutory allocations fund created
- 26 under section 321.145, subsection 2, to the general fund of
- 27 the state the amount of the special fees collected in the
- 28 previous month for endangered species plates. Such moneys
- 29 are appropriated to the department of natural resources to
- 30 distribute in the form of grants to organizations supporting
- 31 ending the degradation of the planet's natural environment
- 32 and building a future in which humans live in harmony with
- 33 nature. In the awarding of grants, the department of natural
- 34 resources shall give first consideration to any official state
- 35 association of the world wildlife foundation and similar

- 1 nonprofit organizations. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys
- 2 appropriated under this subsection shall not revert to the
- 3 general fund of the state.
- 4 e. Upon receipt of the special registration plates, the
- 5 applicant shall surrender the current registration plates to
- 6 the county treasurer. The county treasurer shall validate
- 7 the special registration plates in the same manner as regular
- 8 registration plates are validated under this section. The
- 9 annual special endangered species fee for letter-number
- 10 designated plates is ten dollars which shall be paid in
- 11 addition to the regular annual registration fee. The annual
- 12 fee for personalized endangered species plates is five
- 13 dollars which shall be paid in addition to the annual special
- 14 endangered species fee and the regular annual registration fee.
- 15 The annual special endangered species fee shall be credited as
- 16 provided under paragraph "d".
- 17 f. The department shall not condition the issuance of
- 18 endangered species plates on the receipt of any number of
- 19 orders for endangered species plates.>
- 20 2. Page 3, line 3, by striking <and Gadsden flag> and
- 21 inserting <Gadsden flag, and endangered species>
- 22 3. Page 3, line 10, by striking <and Gadsden flag> and
- 23 inserting <Gadsden flag, and endangered species>
- 4. Title page, lines 2 and 3, by striking <special
- 25 registration plates> and inserting <and endangered species
- 26 special registration plates, and making appropriations>
- 27 5. By renumbering as necessary.
