- 1 Amend House File 2639 as follows:
- 2 1. Page 2, after line 20 by inserting:
- 3 <Sec. ___. Section 321.34, Code 2024, is amended by adding
- 4 the following new subsection:
- 5 NEW SUBSECTION. 11F. Radon mitigation in schools plates.
- 6 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the
- 7 director may issue radon mitigation in schools plates to the
- 8 owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section
- 9 321.109, subsection 1, autocycle, motor truck, motor home,
- 10 multipurpose vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer.
- ll b. Radon mitigation in schools plates shall be designed by
- 12 the department. The background shall be white and the plate's
- 13 numbers and letters shall be red. The left side of the plate
- 14 shall depict a square with the number "86" in the top right and
- 15 the periodic table of elements abbreviation "Rn" in the middle
- 16 of the square.
- 17 c. The special radon mitigation in schools fee for
- 18 letter-number designated radon mitigation in schools plates
- 19 is thirty-five dollars. An applicant may obtain personalized
- 20 radon mitigation in schools plates upon payment of the fee
- 21 for personalized plates as provided in subsection 5, which is
- 22 in addition to the special radon mitigation in schools fee.
- 23 Personalized plates authorized by this subsection shall be
- 24 limited to no more than five numerals, letters, or combinations
- 25 of numerals and letters.
- 26 d. The fees collected by the director under this subsection
- 27 shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and deposited
- 28 in the road use tax fund. The treasurer of state shall
- 29 transfer monthly from the statutory allocations fund created
- 30 under section 321.145, subsection 2, to the general fund of the
- 31 state the amount of the special fees collected in the previous
- 32 month for radon mitigation in schools plates. Such moneys are
- 33 appropriated to the department of education to distribute in
- 34 the form of grants to support radon detection and mitigation
- 35 in schools. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated

- 1 under this subsection shall not revert to the general fund of 2 the state.
- 3 e. Upon receipt of the special registration plates, the
- 4 applicant shall surrender the current registration plates to
- 5 the county treasurer. The county treasurer shall validate
- 6 the special registration plates in the same manner as regular
- 7 registration plates are validated under this section.
- 8 The annual special radon mitigation in schools fee for
- 9 letter-number designated plates is ten dollars which shall be
- 10 paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The
- 11 annual fee for personalized radon mitigation in schools plates
- 12 is five dollars which shall be paid in addition to the annual
- 13 special radon mitigation in schools fee and the regular annual
- 14 registration fee. The annual special radon mitigation in
- 15 schools fee shall be credited as provided under paragraph "d".
- 16 f. The department shall not condition the issuance of radon
- 17 mitigation in schools plates on the receipt of any number of
- 18 orders for radon mitigation in schools plates.>
- 19 2. Page 3, line 3, by striking <and Gadsden flag> and
- 20 inserting <Gadsden flag, and radon mitigation in schools>
- 21 3. Page 3, line 10, by striking <and Gadsden flag> and
- 22 inserting <Gadsden flag, and radon mitigation in schools>
- 23 4. Title page, lines 2 and 3, by striking <special</p>
- 24 registration plates> and inserting <and radon mitigation in
- 25 schools special registration plates, and making appropriations>
- 26 5. By renumbering as necessary.
