1 Amend House File 2639 as follows:

2 1. Page 2, after line 20 by inserting:

3 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321.34, Code 2024, is amended by adding  
4 the following new subsection:

5 NEW SUBSECTION. 11F. *OB/GYN and maternal health plates.*

6 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the  
7 director may issue OB/GYN and maternal health plates to the  
8 owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section  
9 321.109, subsection 1, autocycle, motor truck, motor home,  
10 multipurpose vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer.

11 b. OB/GYN and maternal health plates shall be designed by  
12 the department. The background shall be white and the plate's  
13 numbers and letters shall be blue. The left side of the plate  
14 shall depict a blue circle with a heart-shaped stethoscope  
15 listening to a pregnant belly inside the circle.

16 c. The special OB/GYN and maternal health fee for  
17 letter-number designated OB/GYN and maternal health plates is  
18 thirty-five dollars. An applicant may obtain personalized  
19 OB/GYN and maternal health plates upon payment of the fee for  
20 personalized plates as provided in subsection 5, which is  
21 in addition to the special OB/GYN and maternal health fee.  
22 Personalized plates authorized by this subsection shall be  
23 limited to no more than five numerals, letters, or combinations  
24 of numerals and letters.

25 d. The fees collected by the director under this subsection  
26 shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and deposited  
27 in the road use tax fund. The treasurer of state shall  
28 transfer monthly from the statutory allocations fund created  
29 under section 321.145, subsection 2, to the general fund of the  
30 state the amount of the special fees collected in the previous  
31 month for OB/GYN and maternal health plates. Such moneys are  
32 appropriated to the department of health and human services  
33 to distribute in the form of grants to support pregnant women  
34 in this state. In the awarding of grants, the department  
35 of health and human services shall give first consideration

1 to planned parenthood, and other similar organizations.  
2 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated under this  
3 subsection shall not revert to the general fund of the state.  
4 e. Upon receipt of the special registration plates, the  
5 applicant shall surrender the current registration plates to  
6 the county treasurer. The county treasurer shall validate  
7 the special registration plates in the same manner as regular  
8 registration plates are validated under this section. The  
9 annual special OB/GYN and maternal health fee for letter-number  
10 designated plates is ten dollars which shall be paid in  
11 addition to the regular annual registration fee. The annual  
12 fee for personalized OB/GYN and maternal health plates is  
13 five dollars which shall be paid in addition to the annual  
14 special OB/GYN and maternal health fee and the regular annual  
15 registration fee. The annual special OB/GYN and maternal  
16 health fee shall be credited as provided under paragraph "d".  
17 f. The department shall not condition the issuance of OB/GYN  
18 and maternal health plates on the receipt of any number of  
19 orders for OB/GYN and maternal health plates.>  
20 2. Page 3, line 3, by striking <and Gadsden flag> and  
21 inserting <Gadsden flag, and OB/GYN and maternal health>  
22 3. Page 3, line 10, by striking <and Gadsden flag> and  
23 inserting <Gadsden flag, and OB/GYN and maternal health>  
24 4. Title page, lines 2 and 3, by striking <special  
25 registration plates> and inserting <and OB/GYN and maternal  
26 health special registration plates, and making appropriations>  
27 5. By renumbering as necessary.
