1 Amend House File 2639 as follows:

2 1. Page 2, after line 20 by inserting:

3 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 321.34, Code 2024, is amended by adding  
4 the following new subsection:

5 NEW SUBSECTION. 11F. **Paralympic games plates.**

6 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the  
7 director may issue paralympic games plates to the owner of a  
8 motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109,  
9 subsection 1, autocycle, motor truck, motor home, multipurpose  
10 vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer.

11 b. Paralympic games plates shall be designed by the  
12 department. The background shall be white and the plate's  
13 numbers and letters shall be blue. The left side of the  
14 plate shall depict the logo used by and associated with the  
15 paralympic games.

16 c. The special paralympic games fee for letter-number  
17 designated paralympic games plates is thirty-five dollars.  
18 An applicant may obtain personalized paralympic games plates  
19 upon payment of the fee for personalized plates as provided in  
20 subsection 5, which is in addition to the special paralympic  
21 games fee. Personalized plates authorized by this subsection  
22 shall be limited to no more than five numerals, letters, or  
23 combinations of numerals and letters.

24 d. The fees collected by the director under this subsection  
25 shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and deposited  
26 in the road use tax fund. The treasurer of state shall  
27 transfer monthly from the statutory allocations fund created  
28 under section 321.145, subsection 2, to the general fund of  
29 the state the amount of the special fees collected in the  
30 previous month for paralympic games plates. Such moneys are  
31 appropriated to the department of health and human services  
32 to distribute in the form of grants to support paralympic  
33 games and athletes in this state. In the awarding of grants,  
34 the department of health and human services shall give first  
35 consideration to the Iowa special olympics and similar

1 nonprofit organizations. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys  
2 appropriated under this subsection shall not revert to the  
3 general fund of the state.

4 e. Upon receipt of the special registration plates,  
5 the applicant shall surrender the current registration  
6 plates to the county treasurer. The county treasurer  
7 shall validate the special registration plates in the same  
8 manner as regular registration plates are validated under  
9 this section. The annual special paralympic games fee for  
10 letter-number designated plates is ten dollars which shall be  
11 paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The  
12 annual fee for personalized paralympic games plates is five  
13 dollars which shall be paid in addition to the annual special  
14 paralympic games fee and the regular annual registration fee.  
15 The annual special paralympic games fee shall be credited as  
16 provided under paragraph "d".

17 f. The department shall not condition the issuance of  
18 paralympic games plates on the receipt of any number of orders  
19 for paralympic games plates.>

20 2. Page 3, line 3, by striking <and Gadsden flag> and  
21 inserting <Gadsden flag, and paralympic games>

22 3. Page 3, line 10, by striking <and Gadsden flag> and  
23 inserting <Gadsden flag, and paralympic games>

24 4. Title page, lines 2 and 3, by striking <special  
25 registration plates> and inserting <and paralympic games  
26 special registration plates, and making appropriations>

27 5. By renumbering as necessary.
