Amend the amendment, $\mathrm{H}-8314$, to Senate File 2395 , as passed by the Senate, as follows:
l. Page 4, after line 6 by inserting:
<Sec. -. OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND - APPROPRIATIONS - FY 2024-2025. There is appropriated from the opioid settlement fund created in section 12.51 to the department of health and human services for the fiscal year beginning July l, 2024, and ending June 30 , 2025, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the purposes designated:

1. For a youth substance use treatment and recovery campus in a central Iowa county with a population between 98,000 and 99,000 based on the 2020 federal decennial census:

2. For a nonprofit organization headquartered in a city with a population between 24,500 and 25,000 as determined by the 2020 federal decennial census, that is a member of the Iowa substance use and problem gambling services integrated provider network and specializes in the treatment and prevention of co-occurring mental health and substance use disorders for adolescents and adults, to be used for renovation and expansion of a nature-based recovery campus to provide co-occurring assessment, treatment, and prevention services for both adolescents and adults who are suffering from mental health and substance use disorders, including outpatient, residential treatment, and detoxification:

To provide funding for the renewal, extension, and expansion of an opioid addiction prevention surgery support services agreement entered into by the Iowa attorney general's office that became effective October 1,2022 , to provide surgery care management services to facilitate the reduction of post-surgery opioid use and to optimize therapeutic, humanistic, and economic results from surgery and surgical recovery: ........................................................ $\$ 1,541,700>$
