1 Amend Senate File 2063 as follows:

2 1. Page 1, by striking line 12 and inserting:

3 <a. Compliance with section 155.3.>

4 2. Page 1, by striking lines 13 through 17 and inserting:

5 <b. An offer of employment from a participating nursing
6 home in the state, that has received a minimum quality measure
7 rating of at least three stars from the five-star quality
8 rating system created by the centers for Medicare and Medicaid
9 services of the United States department of health and human
10 services.>

11 3. Page 1, by striking lines 32 and 33 and inserting

12 <trainee a provisional license, and shall waive any continuing>

13 4. Page 2, after line 14 by inserting:

14 <e. The failure of a participating nursing home to maintain
15 the minimum quality measure rating of at least three stars from
16 the five-star quality rating system created by the centers for
17 Medicare and Medicaid services of the United States department
18 of health and human services as specified under subsection 2,
19 paragraph "b", during the entirety of the training period of
20 a current trainee, shall not disqualify the nursing home as
21 a participating nursing home during, or affect the trainee's
22 completion of, the training period.>

23 5. Page 2, by striking lines 20 through 23 and inserting:

24 <5. Upon completion of the training period and payment of
25 the license fee pursuant to section 155.5, the trainee shall be
26 eligible for licensure as a nursing home administrator.>
