1 Amend House File 2690 as follows:

2 1. Page 1, line 16, before <submit> by inserting <may>

3 2. Page 2, after line 5 by inserting:

4 <(4) Average daily water input and maximum daily water input
5 during the reporting period expressed in gallons per day.

6 (5) The primary cooling technology used and whether
7 reclaimed or nonpotable water is used or is technically
8 feasible for cooling.

9 (6) A categorization of water disposition as a percentage of
10 total water input, including evaporative or consumptive use,
11 discharge to sanitary sewer, discharge under permit, and any
12 other disposition category applicable to the facility.

13 c. Information related to public incentives received or
14 approved for the data center, including all of the following:

15 (1) A description of each state public incentive received
16 or approved during the reporting period, including the program
17 name, administering agency, and estimated value or value range.

18 (2) A description of each local public incentive received or
19 approved, including any tax increment financing under chapter
20 403, property tax abatement, rebate, fee waiver, or publicly
21 funded utility extension. The description shall include the
22 governmental entity providing the incentive and the estimated
23 value or value range of the incentive.>

24 3. Page 2, after line 16 by inserting:

25 <5. A data center that does not submit the water usage
26 report required under subsection 2 shall be ineligible to
27 receive any state or local public benefit, including but not
28 limited to any grant, loan, tax credit, tax exemption, rebate,
29 refund, property tax abatement, or tax increment financing
30 under chapter 403 during the period of noncompliance.

31 6. Eligibility under subsection 5 is restored prospectively
32 upon submission of a completed water usage report, but shall
33 not apply retroactively to benefits already received during a
34 period of noncompliance.

35 7. The department shall develop a standardized reporting

1 template for the water usage report required under subsection
2 2. To the extent practicable, the template shall be structured
3 so that a data center may provide the same information to local
4 governments and local water utilities for planning purposes
5 without duplicative reporting. Nothing in this section shall
6 limit a local government's authority to impose additional
7 water-related study or reporting requirements as a condition of
8 zoning, development approval, or permit issuance.>

9 4. Page 5, after line 13 by inserting:

10 <e. Information related to public incentives received or
11 approved for the data center, including all of the following:

12 (1) A description of each state public incentive received
13 or approved during the reporting period, including the program
14 name, administering agency, and estimated value or value range.
