

Senate Joint Resolution 11

H-8482

1 Amend Senate Joint Resolution 11, as passed by the Senate, as
2 follows:

3 1. By striking everything after the resolving clause and
4 inserting:

5 <Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
6 the State of Iowa is proposed:

7 The Constitution of the State of Iowa is amended by adding
8 the following new section to new **Article XIII**:

ARTICLE XIII.

HEALTH CARE TAXATION LIMITATIONS.

11

Section 1. **Two-thirds majority vote for health care tax law
12 changes.** Passage of a bill that increases taxes on health care
13 shall require the affirmative votes of at least two-thirds of
14 the members elected to each house of the general assembly.

Passage of a bill that establishes a new tax on any type of
16 health care shall require the affirmative votes of at least
17 two-thirds of the members elected to each house of the general
18 assembly.

A lawsuit challenging the proper enactment of a bill under
20 this section must be filed no later than one year following the
21 enactment. If such a lawsuit is not filed within the one-year
22 limit, the bill shall be considered properly enacted under this
23 section.

Each bill to which this section applies must include a
25 separate provision describing the requirements for enactment
26 prescribed by this section.

27

The general assembly shall enact laws to implement this
28 section.

Sec. 2. **REFERRAL AND PUBLICATION.** The foregoing proposed
30 amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred
31 to the general assembly to be chosen at the next general
32 election for members of the general assembly, and shall be
33 published as provided by law for three months previous to the
34 date of that election.>
