EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING — APRIL 8, 2019

Meeting. The Executive Council met on Monday, April 8, 2019. The following are highlighted agenda items approved by the Council:

- A personal appearance was made by Executive Officer Christie Templeton of the Department of Human Services to submit a request for Resolution of Funds of \$660,000 pursuant to Iowa Code section [29C.20A](#) in response to the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency for 16 Iowa counties.
- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office for the payment of expenses under Iowa Code section [7D.10](#) in the amount of approximately \$19,800.
- The Council approved a request from the Department of Justice, Attorney General's Office to retain Ryan Clark of Patterson Law Firm, L.L.P. as outside counsel pursuant to Iowa Code section [13.3\(1\)](#) in *Rory Aschbrenner v. Iowa State University, State of Iowa and Second Injury Fund of Iowa*.
- The Council approved a total of approximately \$160,800 in emergency allocations for the following purposes:
 - \$3,800 to the Department of Public Safety for vehicle repairs.
 - \$86,600 to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to repair damage caused by heavy rains and flooding at Dolliver Memorial State Park in Webster County.
 - \$16,900 to the DNR to repair damage caused by heavy rains and flooding at Beeds Lake State Park in Franklin County.
 - \$2,500 to the Iowa Communications Network (ICN) to repair damage caused by erosion along Highway 4 in Emmet County.
 - \$31,600 to the ICN to repair damage caused by erosion along I-80 in Pottawattamie County.
- The Council approved a total of approximately \$92,200 in cost items for the following purposes:
 - \$47,300 to the DNR to repair damage caused by floods to various State parks on September 29, 2016.
 - \$11,200 to the DNR to repair damage caused by floods to Sweet Marsh Wildlife Management Area in Bremer County on July 22, 2017.
 - \$33,000 to the ICN to repair damage caused by erosion to a cable along I-80 at Sugar Creek in Cedar County on September 25, 2018.
 - \$400 to Davis, Brown, Koehn, Shors & Roberts, P.C. for legal services to State agencies.
 - \$300 to Simmons Perrine Moyer Bergman PLC from the Tobacco Settlement Authority.
