EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING — MAY 6, 2019

Meeting. The Executive Council met on Monday, May 6, 2019. The following are highlighted agenda items approved by the Council:

- A personal appearance was made by Executive Officer Christie Templeton of the Department of Human Services to submit two requests for disaster relief to the Council under Iowa Code section [29C.20A](#). The Council approved both requests.
 - The first request was for a Resolution of Funds in the amount of \$385,000 in response to the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency resulting from flood damage in Carroll, Greene, Louisa, Muscatine, Scott, and Wapello counties.
 - The second request was for a Resolution of Funds in the amount of \$385,000 resulting from the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency resulting from tornado damage from July 2018 in Lee, Marshall, Polk, and Van Buren counties.
- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office for the payment of expenses under Iowa Code section [7D.10](#) of approximately \$12,900.
- The Council approved a total of approximately \$72,400 in cost items for the following purposes:
 - \$4,200 to the Department of Public Safety for vehicle repairs.
 - \$2,300 to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for vehicle repairs.
 - \$48,100 to the Iowa Communications Network (ICN) to repair damage caused to cables by erosion along Highway 4 in Emmet County and Highway 13 in Clayton County.
 - \$17,800 for legal fees, including \$9,400 to Barclay Damon, LLP, for legal services incurred in *Department of Revenue v. Windstream Iowa Telecommunications*, and \$4,300 to Foley & Lardner, LLP, for legal advice provided to the Office of the Chief Information Officer.
